Material List

Finished Quilt 15 ³/₈" x 12 ¹/₂"

Thread

Thread should be 40-weight rayon or polyester. Note: Thread colors in underlined italics are used in more than one design.

Ghosts – White, black

Roof – Black/gray ultra-twist or black & white variegated, medium gray

Chimney – Dark brown

Mortar – Brown-gray

Body of House & Dormers – Medium tan, medium gray

Windowpanes – Dark variegated yellow (gold to yellow)

Mutton Bars – Grayish brown

Shutters – Dark purple, brown-gray

Front Door – Dark green

Trees – Brown-gray, dark green, dark gray

Picket Fence – White, medium gray

Cats & Bath – Black, white

Tombstones – Dark gray

Fence Posts – Variiegated brown

Jack-O-Lanterns – Dark orange, gold, variegated brown, black

Grass Against Fence & House –

Medium green, brown-gray

Contour Lines on Hills – Brown-gray

- Black and white bobbin fill thread
- Clear invisible thread
- Quilting thread to match backing and borders
- Quilting thread to match sky, hills, and foreground grass

Fabric

100% cotton, 44"-45" wide

- *Sky* – Fat quarter dark spooky sky fabric
- *Hill* – Fat quarter dark brown batik to

resemble distant hills

- *Foreground grass* – Fat quarter mottled fabric or batik to resemble dead grass
 - *Inner Border and Moon* – Fat quarter mottled yellow batik
 - *Outer Border, Binding and Backing* – ¹/₂ yard of dark gray black batik or mottled fabric
 - *Tulle* – ¹/₃ yard light gray
 - *Batting* – 16" x 19"
- NOTE: Landscape and batik fabrics have many different looks within given pieces. Fabric larger than those listed above might give more scenic selections. Tulle can be found in most fabric stores.*

Notions

- 6" or 8" wooden machine embroidery hoop
- Sewing machine and needles – Microtex 70/10 and 80/12 needles, quilting needles
- Free-motion, darning or big foot
- Permanent ultra fine tip black marker
- White and colored marking pencils
- Removable tape
- Tweezers, scissors, pins, basic sewing supplies
- Rotary cutter, mat and ruler
- Freezer paper
- Temporary water-soluble fabric glue, i.e. Roxanne's Glue Baste It

Stabilizers:

2 yards water-soluble stabilizer, i.e. Solvy or Triple SSS for drawing the design to be thread painted. Stabilizer is clear.
2 pieces 15" x 12" cut-away stabilizer backing

Optional:

- Tilt'Able tray to tilt the machine forward for better visibility
- Stencil maker
- Quilt basting spray

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
