Material List

12 ¾" x 17"

Thread

40-weight rayon or polyester.

Yellow and gold threads should be in the same color family.

Poppies – Rust, medium yellow, medium bright gold, bright gold, dark bright gold, medium orange

Leaves & Stems – 3 shades complementary greens

Butterflies – Bright blue, light blue, periwinkle, dark blue, medium orange

- 60 weight black and white bobbin fill thread
- Invisible thread
- Quilting thread

Notions

- 6" wooden or plastic machine embroidery hoop
- Basic sewing supplies – scissors, 60/8 and 70/10 Schmetz Microtex machine needles, tweezers, pins, etc.

- Open toe free motion, darning or big foot, i.e. such as #15 or #24 for Bernina or a stippling open toe foot for Viking. It is important to see what you are stitching and where the next stitches are going so choose the best foot you can for visibility.

- Sewing machine
- Several colors ultra fine point permanent markers
- 20" 2 ply brown yarn
- Hand embroidery needles

Fabric, Batting, Tulle & Stabilizers

- *Inner Border* – ¼ yard dark green batik
- *Background, Outer Border, Binding and Backing* – ¾ yard of yellow/orange batik (assumes all will be the same fabric)
- *Tulle* – ⅓ yard light gray
- *Batting* – 17" x 21"
- *Stabilizers* – Water-soluble stabilizer film – 6 pieces 10" x 12"

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
